Dear Ladies,

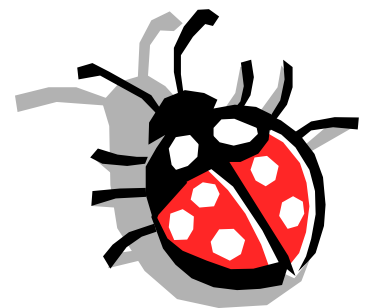
