## MINUTES SUMMARY

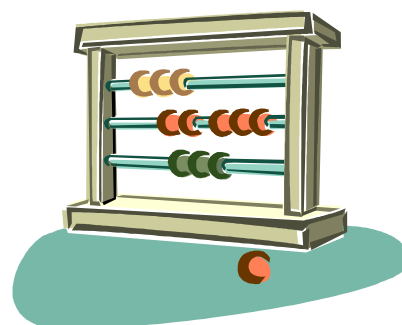

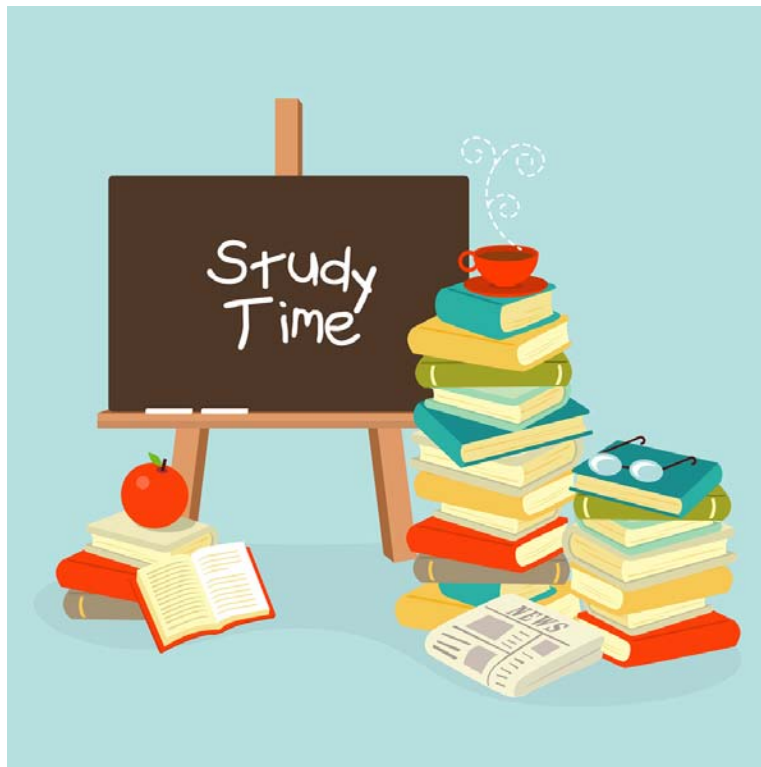
